Travel and parking

Car parking

Parking bays around Broadway House cost £2.20 per hour between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm with a maximum stay of 4 hours. You will need a credit card to pay for the bay by phone.

The nearest Car Park is five minutes walk from Broadway House in Great College Street, Westminster, SW1P 3RX, just off Millbank. Tel: 020 7222 8621.

Public transport

Rail Victoria Station – five minutes walk (or take the Underground one stop)
Charing Cross – ten minutes walk (or take the Underground two stops)
Waterloo – ten minutes walk
For journey planning visit www.tfl.gov.uk and enter the station you are coming from and St James's Park as your destination.

Taxi Black cabs are the best option if you want a taxi and are readily available to flag down in Tothill Street. You won't have to wait more than a couple of minutes for one to appear. There is also a nearby rank opposite the underground station.

There are plenty of local pubs to relax and chat in after your event in Broadway House – just ask reception for the style you want and they will direct you.

The nearest cash-point machines are in St James's Park underground station opposite.

If you are on an overnight stay, or even just here for the day, make the most of being in the vicinity of Broadway House and within five or ten minutes you can be booking up the London Eye; visiting the London Aquarium; taking a boat down the Thames to Greenwich or to the Tate Modern; visiting the more traditional Tate Galleries on the Embankment; or simply picnicking in St James's Park within sight of Buckingham Palace.
